This morning, CAC met and voted on all options. The following three options were recommended for further consideration by the BoE:

- I/IIA – “All Elementary schools become K-6 with the addition of flex space and or portables until such time that the CMS is reopened or new space is found for either.”
- VIII B – “Find a rental location to house the 6th Grade Academy and keep all elementary schools K-5.”
- VIII C – “Find a rental location to house CMS.”

At tonight's Board of Education meeting at 7:30 p.m. in the Staples High School cafeteria, CAC will be presenting its recommendations to the BoE followed by a presentation by District administration. Then, the Board will commence its deliberations.

There will be one more parent feedback session held Thursday evening, December 6 at 7:30 p.m., location to be determined.
