Option 7	Middle school goes on split schedule	Split schedule

Option 9	Redistrict to find space	Use one elementary school for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PreK-K • 6th grade • 8th grade • All of CMS

7. Maintain high standard of educational experience (quality and equity)
